

# FEES

As of February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2008, fees for U.S. passports are as follows (quantities are shown in U.S. dollars):

| **These fees reflect the passport execution fee required for first time applicants. |   |   |
| <b>3. Replacing Lost Passport</b>   | : | Adults - 16 years and over - \$100.00<br>Children - under the age of 16 - \$85.00 |
| <b>4. Passport Card</b>   | : | Adults – 16 years and over - \$45.00<br>Children – under the age of 16 – \$35.00  |

**IN ADDITION, A FEE IS CHARGED FOR THE COURIER SERVICE TO DELIVER THE PASSPORT:**

**\$12.00** if delivery is within the limits of the city of Santo Domingo

**\$16.00** if delivery is to any city outside of Santo Domingo

## Payment of Fees

Passport fees should be paid in **CASH** (either dollars or Dominican pesos), **OR WITH A NATIONAL OR INTERNATIONAL CREDIT CARD** (the charge can only be made in dollars). **Note:** Personal checks, debit cards, U.S. dollar traveler's checks and money orders are NOT accepted.

By law, the U.S. Department of State must recover the true costs of consular services, including the issuance of passports, through customer fees.

It is necessary to periodically adjust the fees to maintain the quality of services and to implement technological advances to improve passport security features.
